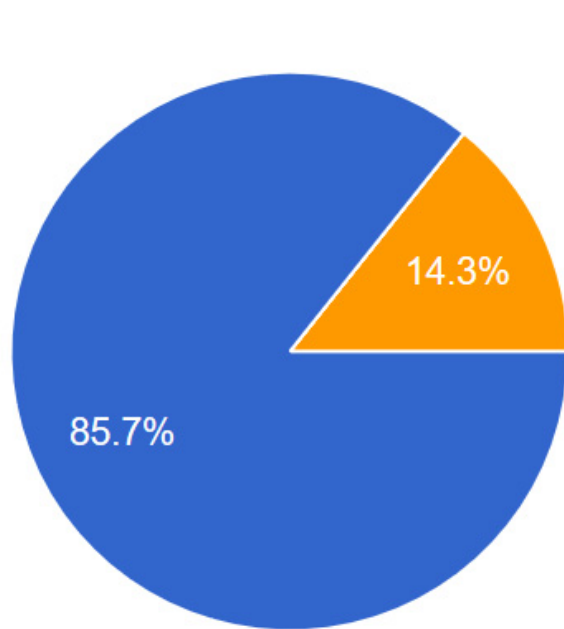

35 responses

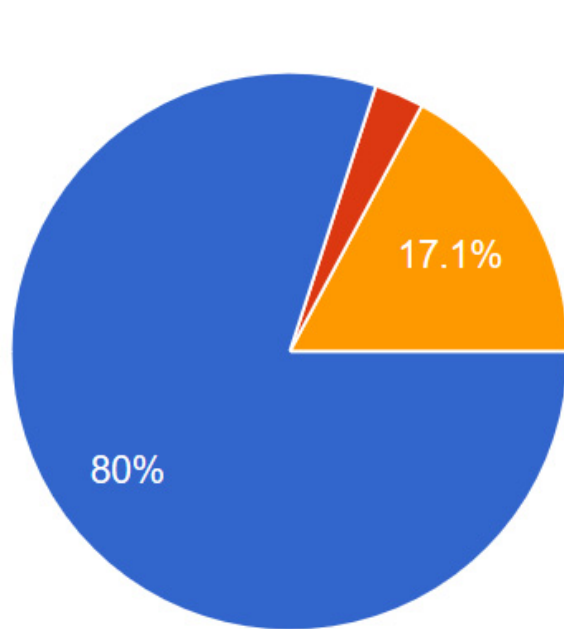


Yes	30 votes (86%)
